Phase 1 includes two 18,000 square foot classroom buildings, which serves as the South Atlanta Campuses for both Georgia Military College and Brenau University; two 2,000 square foot retail buildings and an 11,400 square foot administration building, which serves both as the administrative center for the college as well as the City of Fairburn's main activity center.

Phase 2 of the project includes two additional 14,400 square foot classroom buildings. The first education building in Phase I was completed and occupied by Georgia Military College in November, 2008. The second education building was completed for Brenau in August of 2009.
