Phase I consists of two 18,000 square foot classroom buildings, which serves as the Georgia Military College's South Atlanta Campus; two 2,000 square foot retail buildings and an 11,400 square foot administration building, which serves both as the administrative center for the college as well as the City of Fairburn's main activity center.

Phase II of the project includes two additional 18,000 square foot classroom buildings. The first building in Phase I was completed and occupied by Georgia Military College in November, 2008.
