Group VI Corporation assisted in the master site planning, fund raising, and construction of this 4-acre specialized baseball field located at the Highway 74 South baseball/soccer complex in Peachtree City, Georgia.

The Field of Hope is a ball field which features a rubberized playing surface designed to make it easier for players who have physical disabilities. This surface makes it easier for children using wheelchairs and walkers to participate. The park also includes a concession stand that was designed to be "all-accessible".

The Field of Hope is the second of its kind in the entire country. In Fayette County alone, approximately 2,400 children qualify to participate in the Challenger league, a special program for players with physical disabilities, but many participants travel here from other counties that don't have a similar league.
